**LENTEN REGULATIONS** All Christ's faithful are

obliged by divine law, each in his or her own way, to do penance. However, so that all may be joined together in a certain common practice of penance, days of penance are prescribed. On these days, the faithful are in a special manner to devote themselves to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, to fulfill their obligations more faithfully and to deny themselves, especially by observing fast & abstinence according to the laws of the church. The following are the Lenten penitential regulations issued for the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee:

**Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of **fast**. On days of fast, one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics who have completed their 18<sup>th</sup> year are bound by this law until the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup> year.

**Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent** are also days of **abstinence**. On days of abstinence, meat may not be taken. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14<sup>th</sup> year.

All of the faithful are obliged to do penance, but not all may be able to observe the above regulations of fast and abstinence because of ill health or other reasons. Persons legitimately excused from the laws of fast and abstinence are urged to practice other forms of penance and self-denial suitable to their condition. In addition, the faithful are urged to participate, if possible, in holy Mass during the week; in the sacrament of penance, in Lenten devotions, family prayer, and Scripture

reading; and in sharing of their time and resources with the less fortunate.

**OPERATION RICE BOWL** Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday.

As part of our community's observance of Lent, we ask all families to participate in Catholic Relief Services' Operation Rice Bowl, a program of prayer, fasting, learning, and giving. Please be sure to take home a Rice Bowl Packet (available in the church vestibule) and follow this simple yet powerful Lenten practice. Visit [orb.crs.org](http://orb.crs.org) for more information.

**LENTEN NAILS** Lent is a season of atonement.

Individually & collectively we are called to remember Christ's sacrifice for our sins and to reconcile ourselves to one another. Beginning Ash Wednesday & every weekend during Lent, nails (which symbolize our recollection of Christ's passion & death) will be located at Church to take as a Lenten reminder. Use the nail as a part of your prayer time, when using the Lenten reflection booklet, during Bible study, when giving thanks at meal time and in your small faith community. Consider the nail as an aid in examining your relationship with Christ & your response to His call. Keep the nail until Good Friday when you will be invited to hammer your nail into a cross as a sign of our sins against God and others.
