SECOND DAILY MASS AT GOOD SHEPHERD

Monday-Friday, beginning August 30 at 6:45 AM.

Last summer we surveyed parishioners regarding a time preference for a second daily Mass at Good Shepherd. Of the respondents, 56% selected one or other of the proposed evening time slots for the Mass and 44% for one or other of the morning time options for Mass. At a Worship Commission meeting last September it was decided to try the evening time slot & evaluate at the end of May. Last October we began a second daily Mass at 5:45 PM which continued until July 2. Since a significant number of survey responders indicated a desire for an earlier morning Mass we have decided to try the 6:45 AM Mass beginning August 30. This will be on a **trial basis** through Christmas to gauge the interest and attendance for this Mass time.
