

WING Monthly Meeting Minutes May 4, 2010

Meeting started at 7:45 p.m. with an opening prayer by Vice President Jo Porostovsky. Since we all knew each other, there were no introductions tonight.

Secretary position – Jo reminded everyone that the position is open and an email to the general membership will be sent again to find a volunteer.

Spring Tea – Patricia went over some highlights about the tea on 4/25.

- There were 84 women signed up on our master list but we know there were some women who entered through the side door and didn't sign in.
- There was a discussion about giving numbered tickets in the future even if there is no charge. We could use the half of the tickets for the door prizes.
- Also to limit the number of people to 80.
- Shorten the actual program so women can socialize. Background music can continue but people will have a chance to visit with each other.
- Inform the person in charge of the musicians that the parents/siblings have an area for them with some drinks and cookies, but not invite them to eat from our main table until all our guests had finished eating.

June 6th Reception – As you all know, Father Mike asked WINGS if they could help with food for the reception after the noon mass on June 6th where our parishioner, Kevin McQuone will be celebrating his first mass after his ordination to the priesthood the day before. The church will purchase the food and WINGS is asked to put it together, serve it and clean afterwards. The MOGS will be providing the drinks so they will help with the set up. We will have all the details in the coming weeks.

Kids Consignment Sale – We need a chairman or co-chairs for this event that is coming up very soon. A reminder will be emailed to the general membership.

Quilt – Marsha brought the finished quilt to show everyone. We voted to have this beautiful quilt on display, accompanied by a poster, at Fr. McQuone's reception for everyone to see, and to dedicate the net proceeds (after paying Marsha) to the Good Shepherd's Burse Club. Discussion about how to display it – Jo will check with Al to see if we can borrow one of MOGS' large display boards.

Bulletin announcements will be made as well as information on the website. Phyllis volunteered to take pictures. Ticket sales will be ongoing, culminating with the drawing at the Fall Festival. Tickets will start selling on that day. It was suggested to sell tickets as: \$1 a ticket; 6 tickets for \$5; 12 tickets for \$10; 18 tickets for \$15 and 25 tickets for \$20.

Display Board – Jo will also check with Al if we could share with MOGS a display board – there are two but nobody knew who they belonged to. Maybe we can have one side where we could post pictures of our different events and have it next to our tables when we are signing people in the courtyard. More to come.
