

WING Monthly Meeting Minutes June 1, 2010

Since the church office didn't receive many volunteer desserts, Donna thought about ordering a cake. She will take care of that. Betty Scaringe will shop at Costco's on Friday from a list that Donna is compiling. Since Costco's doesn't provide fruit trays, Betty will buy the fruit and we will put the trays together on Sunday morning. Volunteers need to bring a cutting board and sharp knife.

Marsha brought the quilt for those who had not seeing it. The quilt will be displayed with a poster at the reception and tickets will be sold that day. The proceeds, after paying Marsha for the materials (about \$150) will be donated to Good Shepherds' Burse Club. Phyllis will make a poster as well as the tickets. Patricia will take quilt home and wash it.

There will be bulletin announcements as well as website information for this fundraiser. Phyllis volunteered to take pictures. Ticket sales will be ongoing, culminating with the drawing at the Fall Festival.
