Ministry Update – Music: Vigil rehearsal will be Thursday, March 25 at 7:30, and Saturday, April 3 at 9:30 a.m. The choir chairs are disappearing, some to CHRP, some to the healing service. Ten new microphone cords have been ordered. Church decorating report: At a meeting with Fr. Foley, it was decided that people can donate altar flowers for special occasions and remembrances. Sandy will schedule. Flowers from the garden are acceptable.

Lent and Easter—Flowers and extra music are permitted on Latare Sunday. Arrangements for sound have been made for the outside blessing of the palms. The KCs will strip the palms. Andy will be contacted. The reading of the passion will be like last year, with two people on the altar and two in the choir area. Deacon Ed will contact people for foot washing on Holy Thursday. Bill has the stakes to stabilize the large cross for Good Friday. There will be three crosses for veneration. Mark Schneider has Gary’s Triduum outline. At the Vigil, there will be 11 adults and 3 children baptized, and an additional 12 confirmed. There will be six Old Testament readings by one person each. The lights will go on when the first “Christ be our light” is chanted. The candles will be collected after the baptismal vows. On Easter Sunday there will be no Sequence due to time and traffic.
