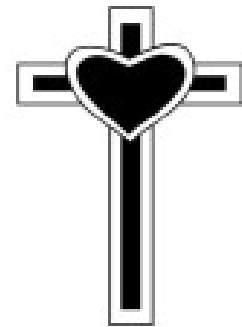
An Invitation to Non-Practicing Catholics
