

GOOD SHEPHERD PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION FOR 2010-2011

Religious Education [RE] = Preschool-Grade 8; Sacrament Preparation Programs

Spring registration is here! Your support is critical to building a strong foundation for outstanding 2010-2011 programs for our children and youth. Please register early; let us know how you would be willing to help; and remember to pray for our children, youth, catechists, parents, and all who work so diligently for the faith formation of our children, youth and adults. Multiple registrations (other than your own family) will not be accepted.



REGISTER FOR:

- ♦ **Preschool.** For 3 & 4 year old & kindergarten (5 year old) classes. Sept. 1 is the cut-off date for determining eligibility.
- ♦ **Grades 1-8.** For students not attending a Catholic school; grades should correspond to those in school. *Copy of the baptismal certificate required for grades 1 & 2 (even if baptized at Good Shepherd).*
- ♦ **Sacraments.** *Copy of baptismal certificate required for sacrament preparation programs (even if baptized at Good Shepherd).*
 - Baptism** Children under 7 (grade 1 or under) - contact the Parish Office at 893-1837; Older children - register for RCIA for children/Youth
 - First Reconciliation & First Communion** (students must be baptized prior to signing up for the 2nd grade sacrament program)
Gr. 2 RE students will prepare for First Reconciliation & First Communion (completion of grade 1 RE/Catholic school required).
Gr. 2 Trinity students will receive a letter in late summer about registering for First Reconciliation/First Communion.
RCIA programs available for older children and youth who have not celebrated sacraments.
 - Confirmation** For 8th grade students in RE and Trinity Catholic School. **NOTE:** Two years of middle school religious education required prior to Confirmation classes. While the Confirmation Program is distinct from the RE classes, these classes are held after the Gr. 8 classes end in February at the same day and time as the RE classes they were attending. Trinity students begin classes in Feb. 2011.
High School Confirmation classes are also available (beginning Feb. 2011).
Confirmation will be sometime around February 2012 for all candidates who begin in Feb. 2011.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION & DATES:

- √ Must be registered parishioners (processed through the Parish Office) of Good Shepherd **PRIOR** to registering for Religious Education.
- √ Registration for programs can be accepted only at those times specifically set for it. Registration opportunities after these dates will be limited.

Students will be assigned to classes at set intervals, and individual classes will be closed when full. (In other words, the longer you wait to register, the more limited your choices may be.) See the other side for information on days & times of classes.

FEES: Payment is requested, **BUT NOT REQUIRED**, at time of registration and may be split, paid later, or waived in cases of need.

Fees: \$40 per student Preschool-Grade 7; \$45 Confirmation; \$75 Grade 8 & Confirmation combined, with a family maximum of \$150.
